1st I hereby revoke and annul all former wills

2nd I give and bequeath and devise to my sister

estate situated in Columbia County Oregon and
described as being the South West quarter of Sec.
21 in T. 5 North Range 5 West and containing
160 Acres

3rd I give bequeath and devise to David Duncan
Kittie Duncan, Francis Lee Duncan
and Bessie Duncan, the children of my
deceased sister Mary Duncan ^{she & shared alike} the following
described real estate situated in the County
of Washington and described as the North West
quarter of Section 18 in Township one (1) North
Range five (5) West of the Willamette Meridian
containing 160 acres.


4th I give devise & bequeath to my nephew David
Duncan my watch.

5" I give, bequeath and devise to my daughter Josephine A. Bush the following described real estate situate in the County of Washington and State of Oregon and described as an undivided one half interest in the West half of Section 16 in Township Three (3) North Range four (4) West of the Will Mer containing in all 320 acres. is

6" I also give and bequeath to my said daughter Josephine A. Bush all my personal property remaining after payment of all my just debts and funeral expenses except what is devised in bequest No 4 heretofore, and fifty dollars for a Tombstone to be placed on my grave. If at any time my sister Mattie Walton should die having any of the property devised to her remaining I direct that the same shall become the property of her children

I hereby appoint my brother Nelson Wiley Executor of this my last will and Testament

In testimony whereof I hereupon sign the foregoing in the presence of S. H. Humphreys and Margaret A. Powell of Multnomah Oregon as witnesses this 30th day of July 1898
