This is the Last Will and Testament of me Richard Talbot of East Burton in the Parish of Winfrith Newburgh in the County of Dorset Yeoman, Made this Thirtieth Day of January in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Three, I Will that all my just Debts and Funeral Expences be paid and discharged by my Executor hereinafter named, I Give and Bequeath unto my Son Richard Talbot's Four Youngest Children the Sum of Twenty Pounds each to be paid to them by my Executors at their Ages of Twenty One Years. I Give and Bequeath unto my Son William Talbot my Leasehold Estate at Burton aforesaid held by me under Thomas Esq. Druce Esquire for the Term of his Life, and after his decease, I Give and Bequeath the said Leasehold Estate unto my Grand Daughter Mary Talbot the Daughter of the said William Talbot for and during the then Remainder of the Term I have therein, I Also Give unto my said Grand Daughter Mary Talbot the Sum of Twenty Pounds to be paid her by my Executors at her Age of Twenty One Years. I Also Give and Bequeath unto my said Son William Talbot my Leasehold Estate late Durrings held by me under Edward Wels Esquire, during the Term of his Life, and after his decease I Give the said Leasehold Estate unto my Grandson James Talbot Son of the said William Talbot for and during the then Remainder of the Term I have therein, I Give and Bequeath unto my two Grandsons the Sons of my Son James Talbot the Sum of Twenty Pounds each to be paid unto them by my Executors at their Ages of Twenty One Years, All the Rest Residue and Remainder of my Goods Chattels and personal Estate whatsoever and wheresoever that I shall be in possession of or Intitled to at the time of my decease I Give and Bequeath unto my Son Stephen Talbot and unto my Grandson Richard Talbot (son of the said Stephen Talbot) jointly and Equally between them to be divided

But in case my said Son Stephen Talbot and my said Grandson

Managing or dividing of the same, then my Will is and I do hereby Order
and direct that my said Grandson Richard Talbot shall pay unto my said
Son Stephen Talbot (his Father) the Sum of Four Hundred and fifty
Pounds in full Satisfaction for his (the said Stephen Talbot's) Share
of my said Personal Estate herein before by me Given to him, And I
do hereby Nominate and Appoint my said Grandson Richard Talbot
Whole and Sole Executor of this my Will. In Witness whereof I have
